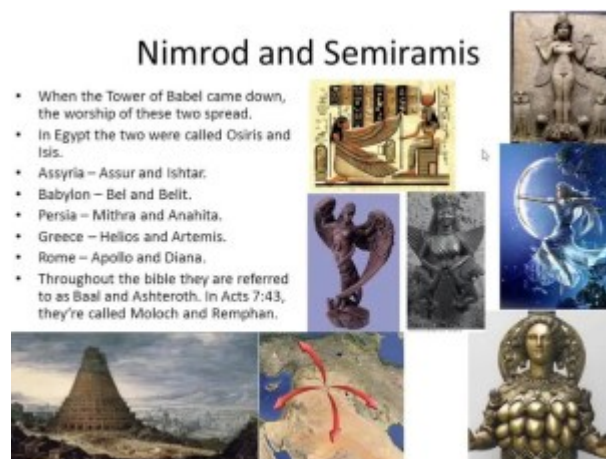


The Two Babylons II. Section II.—Sub-Section II. The Child in Egypt

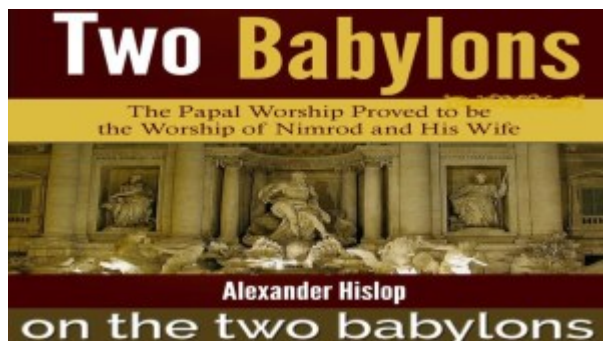
Indulgences have been a source of enormous revenue to the Vatican; by appealing to the superstitious fears of their people, high and low, the popes have filled their coffers with gold.

Pope Francis' Inverted Version of Christianity



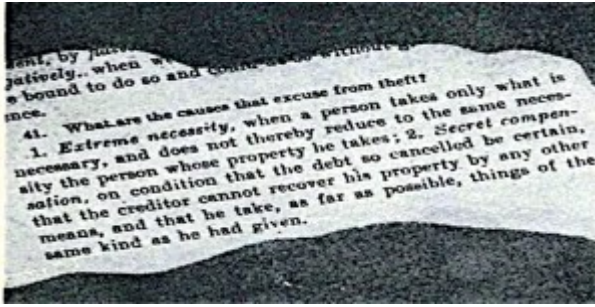
Pope Francis says that we must not judge so-called “pedosexuals” who are sexually attracted to children until we have walked a mile in their shoes.

The Two Babylons – by Alexander Hislop. Introduction



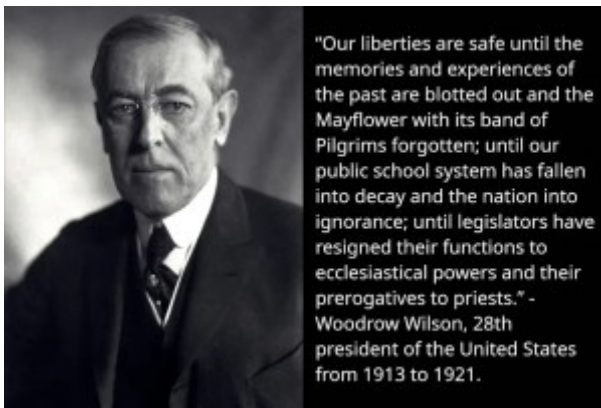

The Celibacy of the Clergy



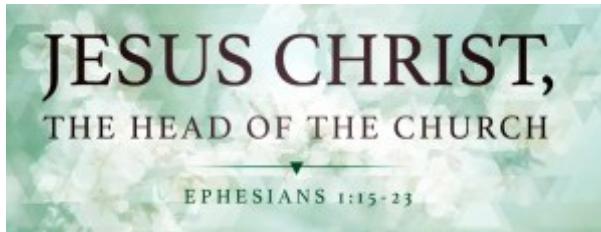
