Dispensationalists call the theological conviction that the Church has

superseded the nation of Israel assuming their role as God's covenanted people, "Replacement Theology." It's also called, "Supersessionism." These terms are both misnomers in my opinion. The correct theological term is, "Covenant Theology." The Church, the ones God called-out of the world, have always been God's covenant people. When Stephen gave his speech to the Pharisees, he called Israel during its time after the exodus and before entering the promised land the "church in the wilderness."

Acts 7:38 This is he, that was in **the church in the wilderness** with the angel which spake to him in the mount Sina, and with our fathers: who received the lively oracles to give unto us:

Are the Jewish unbelievers in Christ Jesus God's covenant people today? Absolutely not. Can they become God's covenant people? They sure can. I've met many brothers and sisters in Christ who were raised Jewish.

God's promise to bless Abraham's seed included the Gentiles!

Genesis 12:3 And I will bless them that bless thee, and curse him that curseth thee: and in thee shall **all families of the earth be blessed.**

What do you think? How clearer can that be? All families of the earth means everybody, both Jews and non-Jews. All true believers in Christ are the children of Abraham.

Galatians 3:29 And if ye be Christ's, then are ye Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise.
