The Last Prophecy: An Abridgment of Elliott's *Horae Apocalypticae*



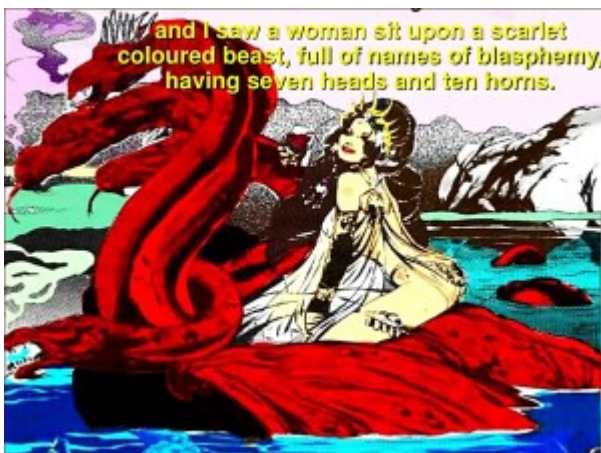
