Apostolic Succession




The Bible shows there was no pope in the Apostolic Church, but it shows also that the laity undoubtedly shared in the management of the Apostolic Church.

The Celibacy of the Clergy





The Church's Object of Worship





The Church's Head and Foundation




The Lord Jesus Christ, is the only Head of the true Church of God. Peter's words of faith, not Peter himself, is the rock that Jesus built His Church

The Church's Rule of Faith




The Word of God, the Sacred Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule of faith and obedience for all true believers.

The Church of God




The true biblical meaning of Church, the called out body of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, not a man made organization such as the Roman Catholic Church.

Religious Liberty and Persecution — Part II




Considering itself superior to the Civil Power, the Roman Catholic Church continues to interfere in the internal policy of governments.
