## The Sacraments Part II



The Roman dogmas of the Eucharist was a medieval superstition, intended to impress ignorant people and greatly increase the power of the clergy, by making the priest appear to have miraculous power, and the people practically dependent on them for salvation.

#### The Sacraments Part I



The sacraments instituted by Christ are baptism and the Lord's supper only. The Church of Rome made seven sacraments in order that it might completely control its people by making them absolutely dependent on the clergy.


### The Church's Head and Foundation



The Lord Jesus Christ, is the only Head of the true Church of God. Peter's


words of faith, not Peter himself, is the rock that Jesus built His Church

#### The Church's Rule of Faith




The Word of God, the Sacred Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule of faith and obedience for all true believers.


### The Church of God




The true biblical meaning of Church, the called out body of believers in the Lord Jesus Christ, not a man made organization such as the Roman Catholic Church.
