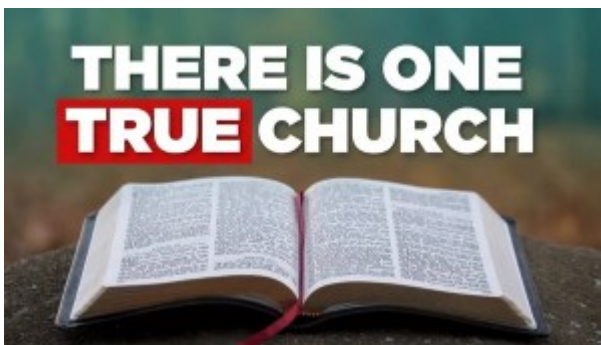

The Church's Rule of Faith



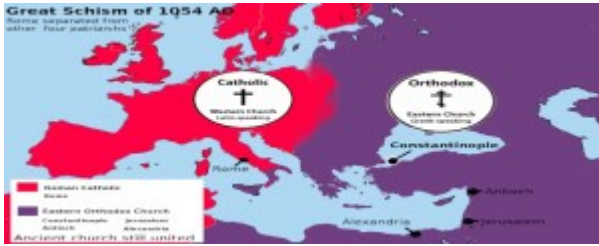
The Word of God, the Sacred Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule of faith and obedience for all true believers.

The Development of the Papal System



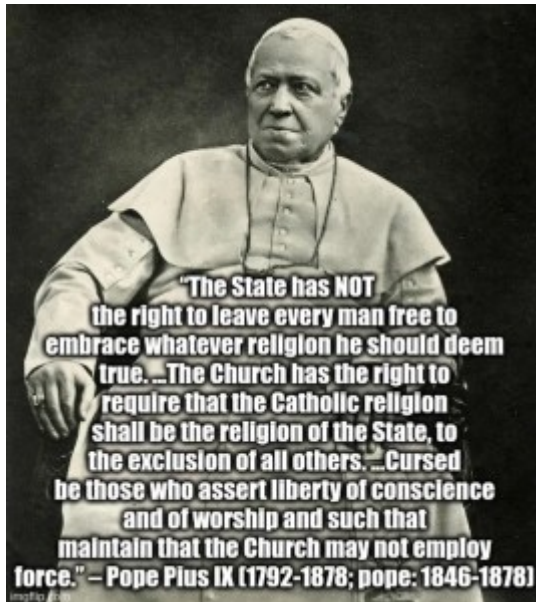
The Great Schism In the Christian Church in 1054 AD is the true beginning of the papacy and the Roman Catholic Church.

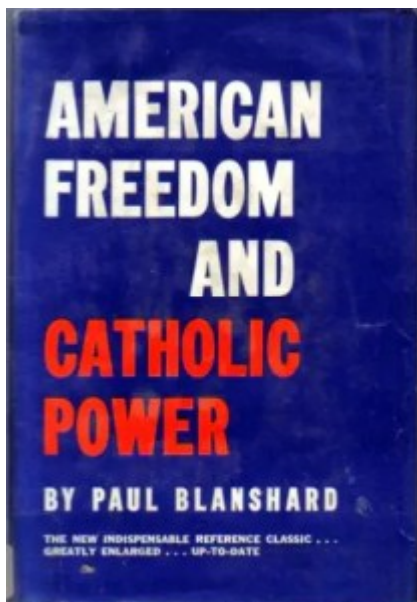
