


Apostolic Succession




The Bible shows there was no pope in the Apostolic Church, but it shows also that the laity undoubtedly shared in the management of the Apostolic Church.

The Church's Object of Worship





The Church's Rule of Faith




The Word of God, the Sacred Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, is the only rule of faith and obedience for all true believers.


Considering itself superior to the Civil Power, the Roman Catholic Church continues to interfere in the internal policy of governments.
