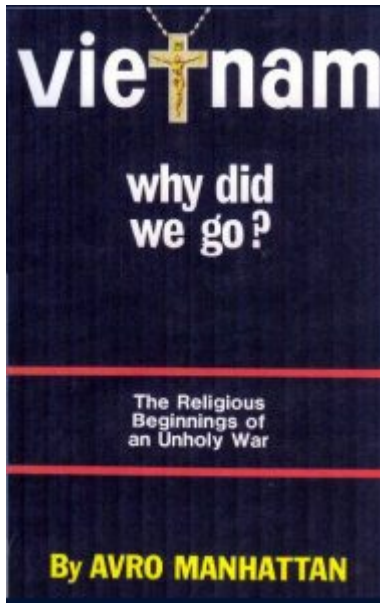


The Main Promoter of the Vietnam War: The Catholic Church



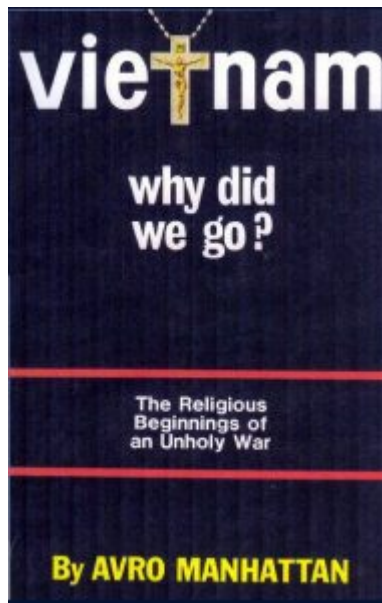
